This list is designed to give you a flavour of what is available and only represents a small selection of what we have in the library.



Relying on their quick wits, the two journey through danger until Torak must make the final sacrifice. Gripping and original.




Robin Hood: Hacking, Heists & Flaming Arrows by Robert Muchamore

This contemporary retelling of a classic tale is action-packed and violent with touches of humour. Exhilarating and unpredictable.




Last Gate of the Emperor by Kwame Mbalia and Prince Joel Makonnen


Combining elements of Ethiopian culture with space-age technology, this fast-paced Afrofuturistic adventure is a thrilling read.




Journey to the River Sea by Eva Ibbotson







AR Book Level 4.6


